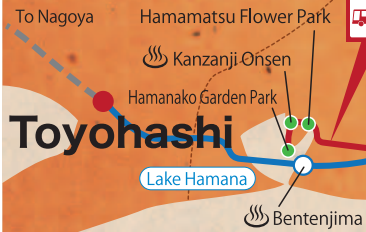

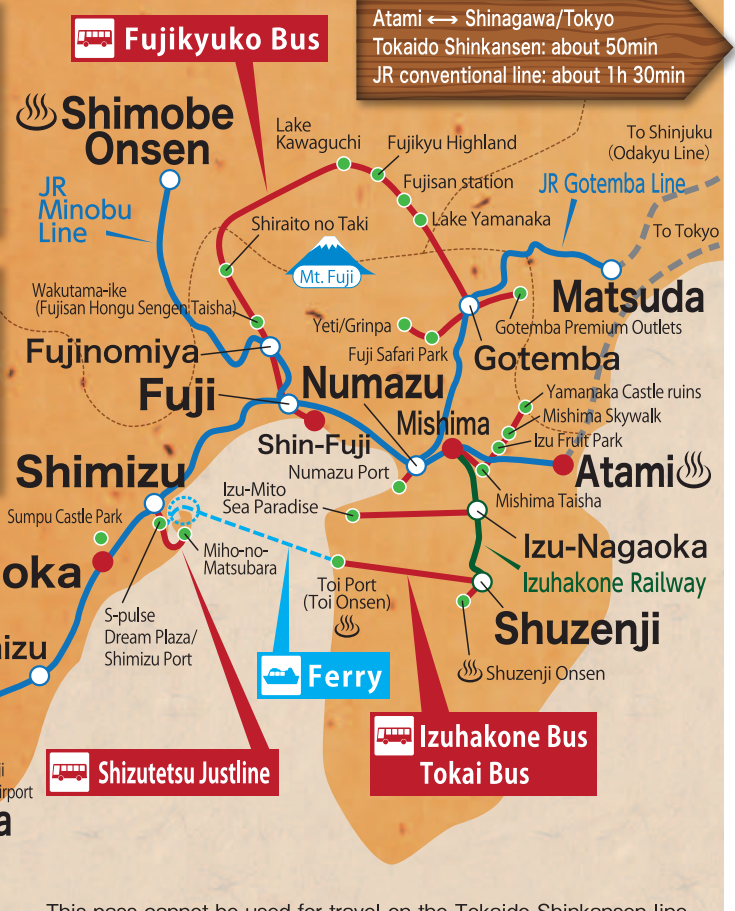

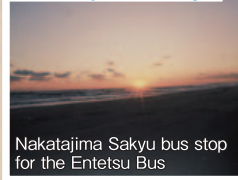

Stations at which Tokaido Shinkansen trains stop are marked by ●. You can exchange your MCO for the pass at stations marked by ● on the map, and the following designated place.
JR Central stations: Tokyo, Shinagawa, Shin-Yokohama, Nagoya, Kyoto and Shin-Osaka JR Tokai Tours branches: Tokyo, Shinagawa and Shin-Yokohama

Examples of travel times (Using JR limited express Using JR non-limited express)

- Atami - Mishima: about 15min (JR)
- Hamamatsu - Toyohashi: about 30min (JR)
- Mishima - Shuzenji: about 35min (Izu Hakone Railway)
- Gotemba - Gotemba Premium Outlets: about 15min (Bus)
- Mishima - Mishima Skywalk: about 25min (Bus)
- Hamamatsu - Nakatajima Sakyu: about 15min (Bus)
- Mishima - Shimizu: about 50min (JR)
- Matsuda - Numazu: about 80min (JR)
- Shin-Fuji - Fujisan station: about 2h 15min (Bus)
- Izu-Nagaoka station - Izu-Mito Sea Paradise: about 25min (Bus)
- Numazu - Numazu Port: about 15min (Bus)
- Hamamatsu - Hamanako Garden Park: about 60min (Bus)
- Shimizu - Hamamatsu: about 1h 25min (JR)
- Fuji - Shimobe Onsen: about 70min (JR)
- Gotemba - Lake Kawaguchi: about 1h 45min (Bus)
- Shimizu - Miho-no-Matsubara: about 25min (Bus)
- Shuzenji - Toi Port: about 55min (Bus)
- Toi Port - Shimizu Port: about 65min (Ferry)
