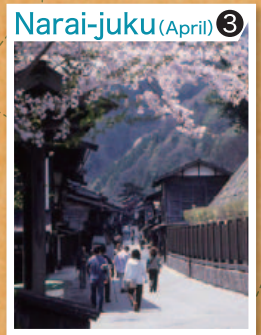

Alpine-Takayama-Matsumoto Area Tourist Pass

Easy and great deal trip to the grand Alpine Route and nearby attractions!

- ✓ Unlimited rides on JR conventional lines running between Nagoya – Gero – Takayama – Toyama, and between Shinano-Ōmachi – Matsumoto – Nagoya! (Use of Home Liner excluded)
- ✓ Unlimited use of transportation within the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route (between Toyama – Tateyama – Murodo – Daikanbo – Kurobe Dam – Shinano-Ōmachi)



Examples of travel time
(Using JR limited express / Using JR non-limited express)

- Nagoya – Matsumoto : about 2h (JR)
- Matsumoto – Shinano Omachi : about 1h (JR)
- Toyama – Takayama : about 1.5h (JR)
- Takayama – Nagoya : about 2.5h (JR)

You can exchange your MCO (Exchange Order) for each pass at stations marked by ● on the map and at the principal stations of JR Central (Tokyo, Shinagawa, Shin-Yokohama, Nagoya, Kyoto and Shin-Osaka) and certain branches of JR Tokai Tours (Tokyo, Shinagawa and Shin-Yokohama).
Each transportation facility may change its holidays and operating hours without notice. Please see the website of each facility for more information.

A diagram indicating the available JR lines, the Alpine Route and tourist spots. Separate admission and access fees to the attractions shown in the diagram may be required.

✓ Reserved seats on ordinary trains of JR conventional lines are usable up to 4 times!

This pass is not available for purchase in Japan. Please purchase an MCO (Exchange Order) before leaving for Japan. Please exchange your MCO for the pass after arriving in Japan.

On sale from April 1, 2016 to November 9, 2016.

• Congestion is expected along the Alpine Route during the Yuki-no-Otani (Snow Wall) season between April and June, and waiting time may be required before using some types of route transportation.
• A "Web Ticket Reservation" for the Tateyama Cable Car leaving Tateyama station is not available with this pass. (You can ride the Tateyama Cable Car without reservation.)

To exchange the MCO, you will need your passport on which a Short-term Stay stamp is affixed during the immigration inspection in Japan.
