### Nagoya Me-Guru Sightseeing Bus

**Tour Nagoya's most famous spots by the lowest-cost way, hopping in & out at will!**

Single ride fare: Adult ¥210, Children ¥100

**1-Day Me-Guru Pass ¥500 ¥250**

• Departures from Nagoya Station Bus Terminal Platform 11 (located on ground level, behind the JP Tower Buildings, from 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM.)  
• Not on Mondays (openness to use day if Monday is a holiday, and from Dec. 29 to Jan. 3.)  
• Ask driver for purchase upon boarding Me-Guru. Other Nagoya City 1-Day Passes and Monaca cards are also accepted.  
• Note: Me-Guru Pass not valid for other buses or subway. Also, last 5:00 PM bus stops at Nagoya Castle, Norikake Garden and Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology stops when returning to Nagoya Station.

Weekend Eco Passes and 1-Day Passes may be purchased at subway stations at the ticket windows or vending machines or at City Buses upon boarding, ask the driver. Passes are accepted on Nagoya City Buses and Subways, but cannot be used on any of the following elevated roads of National Line (from Ome to Obata Ryokuchi), Meitetsu Buses, Aonami Line, Limino, JR Lines and Meitetsu Lines, etc.

**2 The Tokugawa Art Museum** The clan's sumptuous hoard, including a scroll of Japan's oldest novel "The Tale of Genji", a designated National Treasure.

**3 Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology** Experience the long technology that came before cars, by seeing giant machines operate and tremble the whole building.

**4 Higashiyama Zoo & Botanical Gardens** Meet charismatic Shabani, the World's most handsome Western Lowland Gorilla, and visit an astounding vast garden!

**5 SCMagLEV and Railway Park** A train museum with the world's fastest Linear Motor Shinkansen Conduction MAGLEV.

**6 Atsuta Jingu Shrine** One of Japan's Three Most Important shrines, guarding the God-given sword!

**7 Nagoya City Science Museum** Home to the world's largest planetarium, it's a fascinating place of science and fun!
