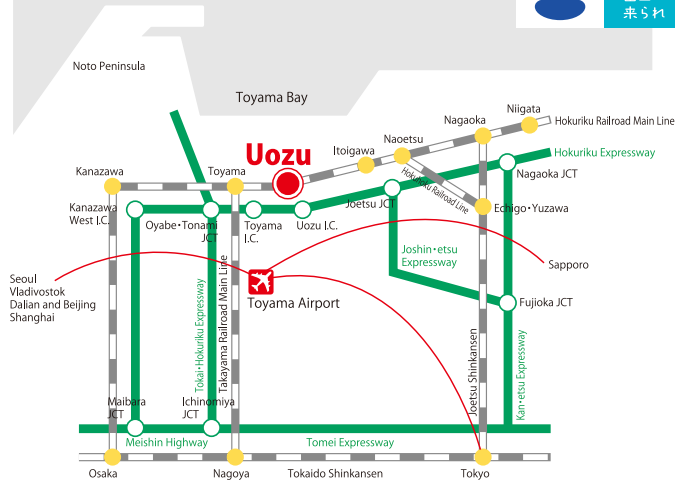

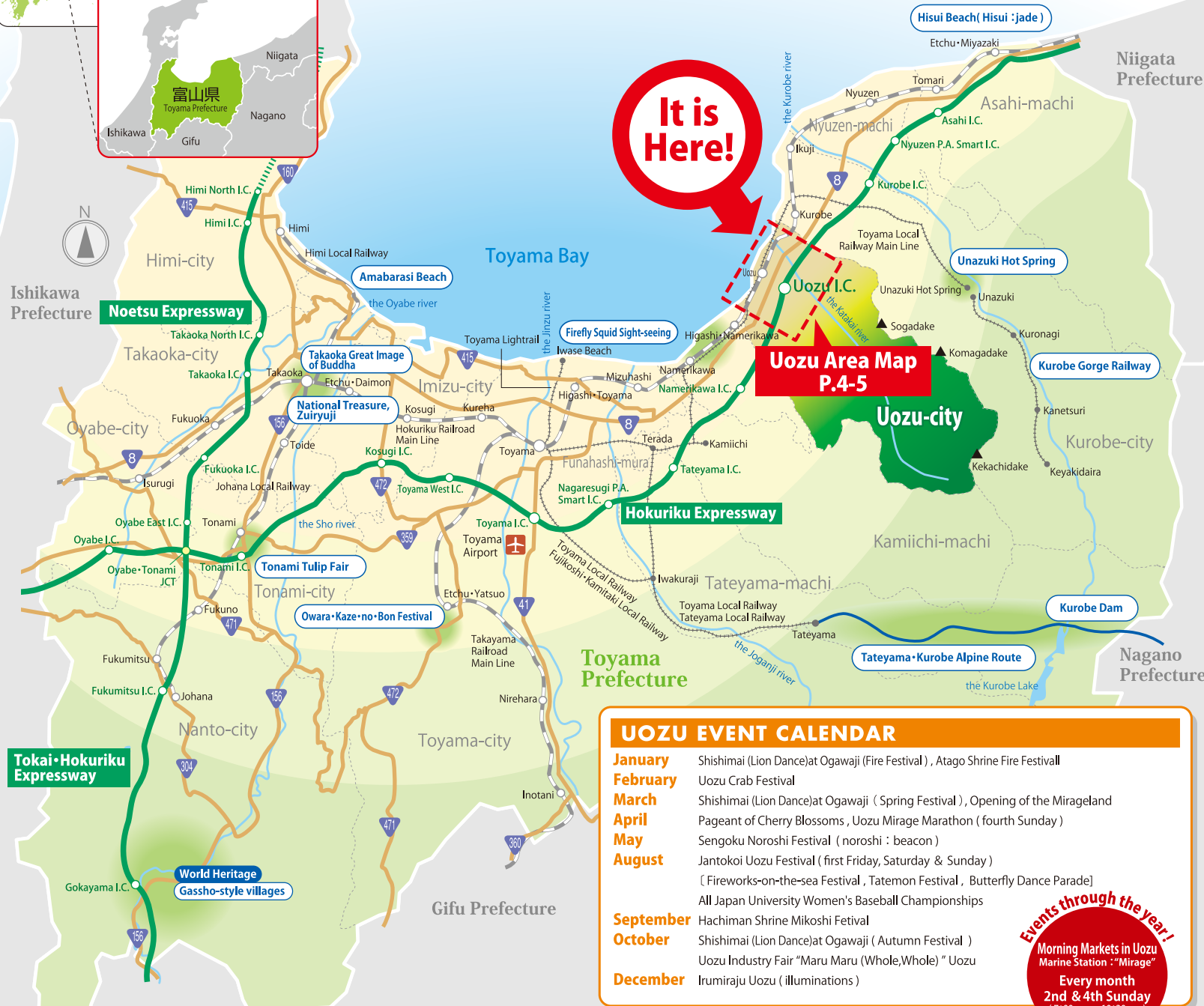

UOZU AREA MAP

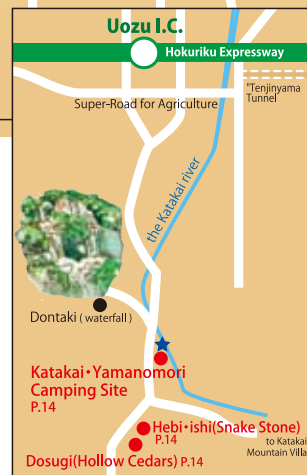

Showing Various Expressions, Secrets of Mirages

Mirages are phenomena in which the images that the light caused refractions by the differences in temperature (density difference) in the atmosphere, and distant sceneries and etc are extended or reversed and appear.

The upper mirages (in spring) are seen as the virtual images in extended or reversed above the real sceneries and the lower mirages (in winter, the other way) are seen the

virtual images below the real sceneries. The upper mirages are easily seen in late March to early June, the temperature more than 18 Celsius, by a breeze of north-north east.

As the records in the year 1564 Ken-shin Uesugi, in 1700s Lord Tsunanori Maeda of Kaga Districts, and in 1797 Lord Harunaga Maeda had seen mirages.

Feeling the length of the year 2000

About 2000 years ago the Burial Forest was thought that cedars had been buried by the sands caused by overflowing of the Katakai river and afterward due to rises of the sea it had been submerged. The whole places where the forests had grown were shut down in the underground and not only tree stocks but also seeds, pollens and insects had been remained in the sea. And these're big clues to guess the past environments.

In August, first Friday, Saturday & Sunday



“Jantokoi” Uozu Festival

In August, on first Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the Festival is held by a main “Tatemons” of Suwa Shrine. On the sea fireworks color a night sea brilliantly.

Tatemon Festival

Tatemons are important National Folk Cultural Properties and they're consisted of a big pillar of 15m high and have 90 paper lanterns decorated by a shape of a sail and are built on a boat (float) weighing 1.5 tons and are pulled enthusiastically. This Festival originated in Edo period is brave and gorgeous and is rural scenes of summer in Uozu.

◆ A Sengoku Noroshi (smoke signals : Beacon) Festival at Matsukura (May)

This is an event full of “Romantic” in the age of the Civil War (Sengoku period) in Uozu where at that time it had flourished in the mountain castles as strategic points.



◆ Shishimai (Lion Dance) at Ogawaji (March, October)

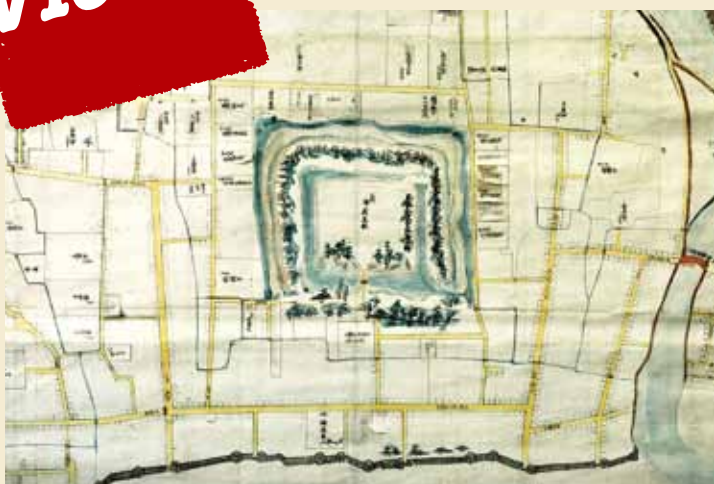
This is a very unique Festival handed from the Muromachi period that the divine services and the Buddhist services are fulfilled at the same time. “Folk Cultural Properties designated by this Prefecture”



Serikomi Butterfly Dance

People dance as if the butterfly turn round with fans, sedge hats or lanterns. With a full of atmosphere it's one of typical folk lores in Toyama Prefecture. “City Intangible Folk Property”

■ Fierce Battles of Uozu Castle (Ruins of Uozu Castle)

During the warring states period Nobunaga Oda aimed to reign this country continuing to fight with the armies of Kagekatsu Uesugi, Uozu was a place of "The Battles of Uozu Castle" in the year Tensho 10 (1582) called as "The Tragedy of the Uesugis."

■ Ruins of Matsukura Castle

Matsukura Castle is called a mountain castle built on the mountain (430m above sea level) that is called "Kakuma." and also the one in Etchu Districts that has an eminent scale. It flourished as the center of the east Etchu (Toyama Pref.) until it had fallen in the year 1583.



■ Ruins of Tenjinyama Castle

It was one castle of the Matsukura castles and was an important relay point of Uesugi armies. During the battles of Uozu Castle Kagekatsu Uesugi of Echigo (Niigata Pref.) districts took up positions for their defenses.



■ Mantodai(Old Lighthouse)

At about the end of Edo period the first Lighthouse of Uozu Port kept the safe routes in the dark night and prayed for the safety of the sea to put the Jizo (stone idol) in it. By lending 360 Kans (weight unit) to 12 oil sale shops and getting its interests, they paid these oil money for it and was said that the lights of this Lighthouse had never been gone out.

■ Kenshin Uesugi's Poetry Stone Monument & Tokiwa (evergreen) Pine Tree.

When Kenshin Uesugi of Echigo districts (Niigata Pref.) marched into Etchu districts, he sang to himself in the strong feeling with the armors at the place of Uozu Castle in the early autumn. Beside the monument "Tokiwa Pine Tree" showing a connection with Kenshin Uesugi had been planted.

■ Birthplace of Rice Riots

In the era Taisho 7 fishermen's wives of several 10 who had been suffering from the inflation of rice price and decided to stop shipping straw rice bags, and so rice riots took place from here. And its traces still remain in the bank building and the Warehouse.

Uozu Historic Folk Museum

It is in the half way of Tenjinyama to drive for about 10 minutes from JR Uozu Station and is Uozu's historic spot consisting of 3 buildings of Yoshida Memorial Home Museum, Uozu Historic Folk Museum and Old Sawasaki Home.

Dosugi Gun (A Crowd of Hollow Cedars)

The place of a crowd of the natural cedars supposed to be more than 500 years of the age close to 500m above sea level of Minami Matadani Valley. They're called "Hollow Cedars" because they have hollow trunks and its diameter is 16m at its maximum.

Hebi-ishi (Snake Stone) or Dragon Stone

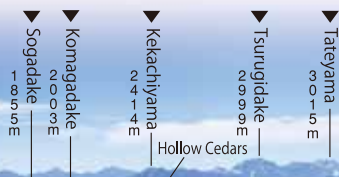

Toyama Bay is abundant in treasures of fish and they're caught from the very deep sea "Aigame" and you can taste tight marine products at all seasons.

Spring



Uozu Kanhagi (Black Scaper)

Season : December ~ mid-February

Black scaper is caught in the coldest season in December to mid-February are best when you eat Sashimi (raw fish) in the soft meat covered by thick films.



Hotaruika (Firefly Squid)

Season : March ~ around May

Small light emitting squids telling us a coming spring at Toyama Bay are caught by big nets settled in the near sea. It's a best way to eat with mustard, vinegar Miso spice.



Iwagaki (Rock Oyster)

Season : June ~ around August

Rock oysters're best in August. There's big meat in the 20cm shells and it's delicious to eat it in raw, roasted or fried.



Baigai (Whelk)

July ~ around August (in season & all year round)

Whelk caught by the net fishing in Toyama Bay are "Oh-Etchu Bai" and "Tsubai" and etc. The best way is to eat Sashimi (raw fish) and the meats are also cooked sweetly and roasted with butter.



Genge (Porous-head Eelpout)

season : September ~ around June

Porous-head eelpout full of collagen caught by dragnet fishing season in September to next June. It's a recommendation and good to eat French fried ones.

Summer



Beni-zuwaigani (Red Queen Crab)

season : September ~ around next May

Winter taste is crabs. "Crab cages" used by the crab fishery in all this country were the invention by Toramatsu Hamada.



Amaebi (Sweet Shrimp)

season : November ~ around February

Sweet shrimps grown in Toyama Bay whose depth of water rapidly deepen into 200m to 500m are attractive to eat them when first caught.

Autumn



Buri (Yellowtail)

season : December ~ around February

As for Toyama, Yellowtails! A big one over 10kg is superb because of abundant fat. These ones are the best tastes because they're natural ones survived the harsh waves of the Japan Sea.

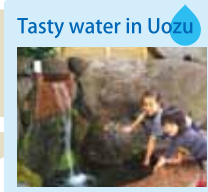
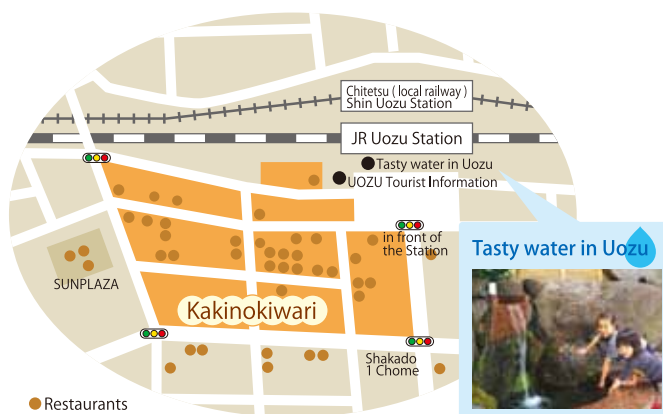

Restaurant Streets in Uozu, "Kakinokiwari" ?

That's a nickname in front of JR Uozu Station Restaurant Streets. The area gathering more than 200 restaurants was once a place name of Muraki Kakinokiwari. Kakis (perssimmon) have lots of images on foods and drinks of effects of getting sober, relishes (Kakinotane), Kakinoha sushi, pickles made of vinegary dishes and on the rock. And "Kakinokiwari" was named by associating "Mizuwari (on the rock, cocktail)"
